As a writer and producer, Jamie Scott is responsible for ten UK Number 1 albums, four US Number 1 albums and four UK Number 1 singles. These are estimated to have sold over 75 million albums and 75 million singles globally in addition to being streamed over 7 billion times on Spotify.

Hipgnosis has acquired 100% of Jamie Scott's interest including all BMI and PRS income in his catalogue which comprises 144 songs.

Jamie Scott was represented by longtime manager Richard Wilson as well as Gavin Maude and Ryan Vince at Russells and Daniel Ross at Ross Bennet Smith.
