Brian Higgins has collaborated closely with Girls Aloud, helping them become the UK's biggest selling girl group of the 21stcentury, with over 4.3 million singles sales and 4 million albums sold in the UK alone. This includes co-writing and producing most of their five studio albums, all of which achieved either platinum or double platinum status in the UK. Brian Higgins also co-wrote or produced their Number 1 hits 'Sound Of The Underground', 'I'll Stand By You' and 'The Promise'.

In 2008, Brian Higgins co-wrote and produced Gabrielle Cilmi's 'Sweet About Me', which reached Number 1 in three countries and was named the most played song in the UK during 2009 by PRS for Music.

Brian Higgins was named UK producer of the year in 2009 and has also written or produced hits performed by Pet Shop Boys, Dannii Minogue, The Saturdays, Sophie Ellis-Bextor, Bananarama, Alesha Dixon, Texas, Rachel Stevens, Saint Etienne, Gossip and Florrie.

Hipgnosis has acquired 100% of Brian Higgins' worldwide copyright, ownership and financial interest, including the writer share, of his catalogue comprising 362 songs.

Brian Higgins was represented by manager Mark Beaven at AAM and lawyer Michael Guido at Carroll Guido Groffman Cohen Bar & Karalian, LLP.
